In supersession to this office order of even reference dated 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 and in exercise of the powers conferred by Central Government vide Notification No. S.O. 189(E) dated 19<sup>th</sup> January, 2017 of the Ministry of Labour and Employment the undersigned hereby revise the rates of Variable Dearness Allowance on the basis of the average Consumer Price Index for Industrial workers reaching 357.65 from 345.22 as on 31.12.2021 (Base 2016-100) and thereby resulting in an increase of 12.43 points. The revised Variable Dearness Allowance as under shall be payable from 01.4.2022;-
